













Crashes by Year and Severity











EFFECTIVE MAY 18, 2024

City of Alexandria Ordinance 5544, enacted on May 18, 2024, establishes the amount of fare to be charged as follows:








Adaptive Traffic Signal Control





Smart Roadway Project






- The project will use advanced cameras and sensors to create a real-time digital inventory of roadway assets such as pavement, sidewalks, signs, and markings.
- It will support data-driven infrastructure maintenance and help prepare the City for connected and autonomous vehicles by evaluating technologies and their integration with City operations.

Smart Intersection Pilot

- This pilot project evaluated advanced machine learning tools capable of identifying vehicles, buses, pedestrians, and cyclists, as well as detecting near misses and analyzing traffic patterns.
- In partnership with the Virginia Tech Transportation Institute (VTTI), the City deployed these tools at key
 intersections to assess their effectiveness in real-world conditions.









King Street-Bradlee Safety and Mobility Enhancements






Proposed Eisenhower Ave Cross-Section Van Dorn St to Metro

Duke and Route 1 Safety Improvements




Route 1 South
